SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of Grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire Parish Community. Preparation class is held the last Wednesday of each month at 7pm. Please call the office to RSVP. A Parish is a certain community of the Christian faithful stably constituted in a particular church, whose pastoral care is entrusted to a pastor (*Code of Canon Law #515*). Therefore, it is important for parishioners to register for contact and pastoral reasons. You must have a sponsor letter from the parish in which each of the godparents reside. A godparent must have received the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, Holy Communion and, if married, have been married in the Catholic Church.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage. Couples seeking to be married at All Saints need to fulfill the All Saints pre-marriage process. The Wedding Coordinator and/or the Pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the Parish Office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

After Hours Sick Calls: In case of serious illness after hours, please call 803-493-1714 and leave a message.

FOOD DRIVE



The All Saints Council of the Knights of Columbus is sponsoring a food drive as part of their Food for Families Program. This month the Clover Area Assistance Center (CAAC) is in need of: canned meats (tuna, chicken, salmon, spam, ham), instant potatoes (boxed or bagged), flavored boxed potatoes (scalloped, Au gratin), canned greens (i.e., collards, turnip, spinach), canned vegetables (beets, asparagus, cabbage, mixed veggies), canned beans (cannellini, navy, black eyed peas, kidney and pinto), canned tomato products (stewed, crushed, whole, Manwich sauce), boxed stuffing, canned pork and beans, beanie weenies, instant brown rice, pasta, ramen noodles, macaroni and cheese, condiments (ketchup, mustard, mayo), soft breakfast bars, soft granola bars, jelly, toilet paper, and dish soap. PLEASE NO CANNED CORN or GREEN BEANS. These will be distributed to needy families in our community. Please take all food items for FOOD FOR FAMILIES to the main kitchen. Collection will take place the weekend of January 4th and 5th. We collected #380 of food last month. The next food drive will be the weekend of February 8th and 9th.



Trip to Rome Shrines of Italy

An information meeting and slide presentation on Thursday, January 16th at 10:30 am in the PLC for Father John's pilgrimage to Rome and other holy places scheduled for October 2025. Light refreshments.

Why? "But they did not understand what he said to them."

Mary and Joseph have just experienced every parent's worst nightmare: their son was missing for THREE DAYS, as they searched and asked and retraced the steps of their journey. Imagine their relief when they returned to the Temple and saw him at last. Surely they ran to him with joy and exasperation, only to hear his answer, "Why were you looking for me?" Why? WHY?!

Of course they did not understand what he said to them. Their hearts had gone through the wringer of fear and anxiety, their imaginations had probably thought of worse case scenarios, their minds could not understand why he would separate himself from the ones who loved him and had supplied his every need in every moment of his life up until then. And he seems to give a dismissive answer, "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?" Like a sword to the hearts of Joseph and Mary, his response does not seem to take their anxieties into account.

This is hard to understand, so hard that Mary must store it away to ponder later, as we are told she "kept all these things in her heart." But he returns to their home in Nazareth, and is obedient to them.

This Holy Family did not have a schedule given to them from Heaven. Yes, they were holy; yes, Jesus was the Incarnate Son of God; yes, Mary was sinless; yes, Joseph was a just man. They were good Jews, subject to the Jewish Law and open to the will of the Father. But they did not know where the will of the Father would take them. It took them to Bethlehem when they should have been preparing at home for the birth of Jesus. It took them to Egypt for several years to flee the murderous rage of Herod when they wanted to return home with their infant. It took them back to Nazareth at last, where they raised a child they knew to be the Messiah. And it took them over a painful journey of three days to find him in the Temple.

What did this require of them? The same thing that it requires of us: loving trust. They are the model for us of a life of love and trust, obedience and patience, great faith and hope and humility, knowing the will of the Father is always for our good, even when it is difficult.

Let us pray for the grace to continue to submit ourselves to the will of the Father, especially when it is hard to understand, when it seems something else would be better, when it costs us. It is then that our trust is deepened and our love grows.




